The Most Holy Trinity

**“Stewarding our Gifts: Go in peace glorifying the Lord by your life.”**

“Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; to God who is, who was, and who is to come. “ (Rev 1:8) Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity, one of the greatest mysteries of our faith. Readings such as the one from Exodus remind us that God the Father has always engaged in covenants with his people. And the Old Testament makes multiple references to the Holy Spirit moving amongst the people. But the ultimate gift – God’s greatest covenant – is presented in the form of Jesus Christ, who is fully human and fully divine. “For God so loved the world that He gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life.” (Jn 3:16) Take a moment today to think about the gift of the Most Holy Trinity. 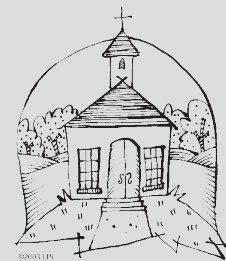
