## Stewardship Message— “Who are you Following?”

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Am 7:12-15 / Eph 1:3-14 / Mk 6:7-13

Service is an integral part of being a good steward. Some people shy away from serving others because they feel underequipped or, in some way, incapable. You only have to look at today's readings to see that God does not require anything more than a willing heart. In the first reading we see the prophet Amos, a shepherd, called into the service of the Lord. In the Gospel we find the disciples, sent two by two, to spread the Good News to all the corners of the Earth. To be a good steward does not require college degrees or letters of recommendation. Rather, it requires eyes that seek opportunities to do God's will and hands that are willing to do the work. Amos was called out of the simple life of a shepherd. Matthew was a despised tax collector. Peter was a fisherman. God is calling everyone into service. God is calling YOU. Will you respond?

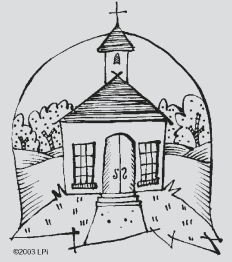
