Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Deut 18: 15-20 / 1 Cor 7:32-35 / Mk 1: 21-28

When it comes down to it, stewardship is a form of servant hood. We are called to use our gifts to serve God and to serve one another. is what Jesus does in today's Gospel, as He establishes His public reputation. Jesus demonstrates His authority over the demon, and casts the evil spirit out of the man. Clearly, Jesus has some special gifts -- gifts that He could have used for His own glorification. Instead, He used His divine authority to free the man of the demonic possession. Jesus used His gift to heal a man, rather than using it to control him. Let us remember this as we put our own gifts to use. We are stewards of all God has given us, and we are to use those gifts in the service of the Lord!

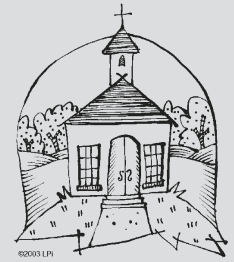
