Stewardship Message— A Tender Shoot

Ez 17: 22-24 / 2 Cor 5:6-10 / Mk 4:26-34

Today's first reading offers a beautiful image of tearing off "a tender shoot" from a cedar tree and planting it on a high mountain. Most of us are quite familiar with the cedar tree — it's unique aroma and the supple nature of its young branches. Let's apply this image to our own discipleship. A tender shoot, torn off a more mature branch, can be planted straight into the ground. This little shoot-like you and I—may have been comfortable where it was, but it has been called to another task. It is young, but it has a powerful life force within it. This shoot has been carefully selected and planted with great purpose. Like this little branch, you and I are sometimes thrust into positions that we didn't choose; but we always have the ability to choose how we respond. FIAT means recognizing the life force within us and trusting God to use us as He sees fit.

DOCTRINAL SECTION-TRINITY SUNDAY

Take thought now, redeemed man, and consider how great and worthy is he who hangs on the cross for you. His death brings the dead to life, but at his passing heaven and earth are plunged into mourning and hard rocks are split asunder. It was a divine decree that permitted one of the soldiers to open his sacred side with a lance. This was done so that the Church might be formed from the side of Christ as he slept the sleep of death on the cross, and so that the Scripture might be fulfilled: They shall look on him whom they pierced. The blood and water which poured out at that moment were the price of our salvation. Flowing from the secret abyss of our Lord's heart as from a fountain, this stream gave the sacraments of the Church the power to confer the life of grace, while for those already living in Christ it became a spring of living water welling up to life everlasting. Arise, then, beloved of Christ! Imitate the dove that nests in a hole in the cliff, keeping watch at the entrance like the sparrow that finds a home. There like the turtledove hide your little ones, the fruit of your chaste love. Press your lips to the fountain, draw water from the wells of your Savior; for this is the spring flowing out of the middle of paradise, dividing into four rivers, inundating devout hearts, watering the whole earth and making it fertile.
