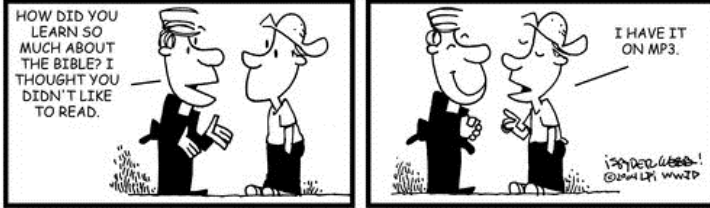
St. Mary School Happenings

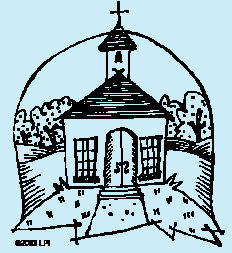
