CYM at NCYC!

Please remember in your prayers the group from CYM (Catholic Youth Ministry) who are attending the NCYC (National Catholic Youth Conference) in Indianapolis, IN. this weekend. We have 6 youth from our CYM plus several adults.

NCYC is a three-day event held every two years. During the conference, there is music, prayer, workshops, liturgy, and opportunities to participate in the Sacrament of Confession. There are also concerts, dances, and a comedy club at NCYC. The thematic park is an area set up with interactive educational and recreational activities, as well as traditional exhibits and vendor booths in what is known as the "thematic park".

The 2013 NCYC will be held at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis. The event's main sessions will be broadcast around the world online. During the day, the participants will spend the day in the Indianapolis Convention Center for small workshops and influential speakers. Christian artist Matt Maher will be making an appearance. Over 23,000 are expected to attend.

A special session for the youth to share their experience of attending such an amazing event will be held on **Jan. 5th from 1-3pm in the JPll room.**

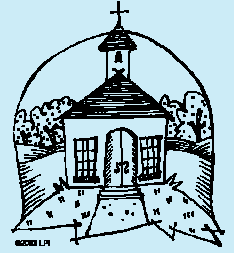
