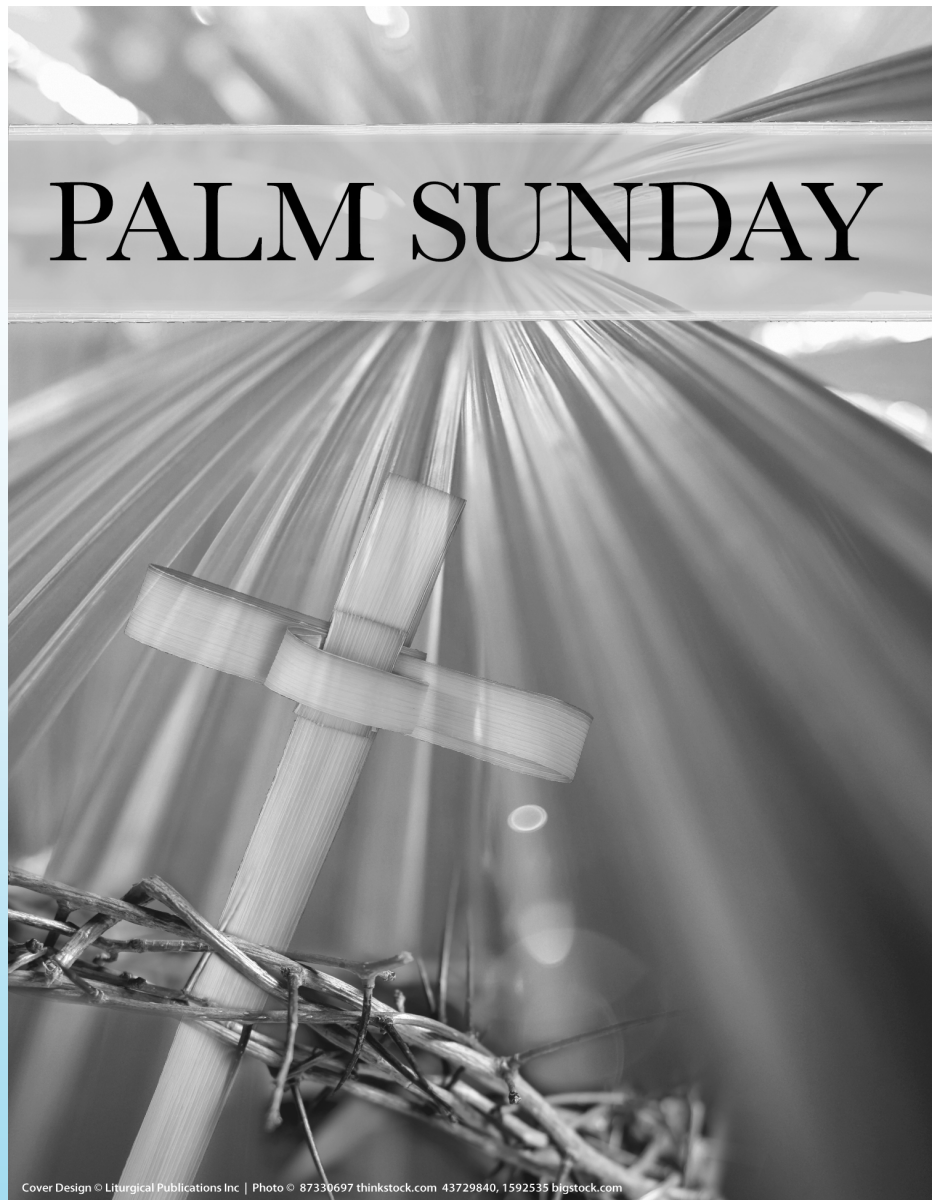

"What Gifts Do I Share?"

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

How willing are we to share the gifts God has given us? In the Old Testament, Isaiah had the gift of prophesy, hearing and interpreting the Word of God for the people of his time and for us. Though he was subject to abuse by some of his listeners, he continued to share freely what he had received. In these last days of Lent we focus on the gift of God's love represented in Jesus coming to earth to offer Himself as a sacrifice for our sins. The story of the passion shows us a portion of the divine love that God showers on us. But that divine portion nearly overwhelms our human capabilities! Jesus' offering of his very life becomes an example of the loving generosity of the Father, who supplies each of us with the strength to do his will. May the Passion of our Lord strengthen us to share God's love in this world!
