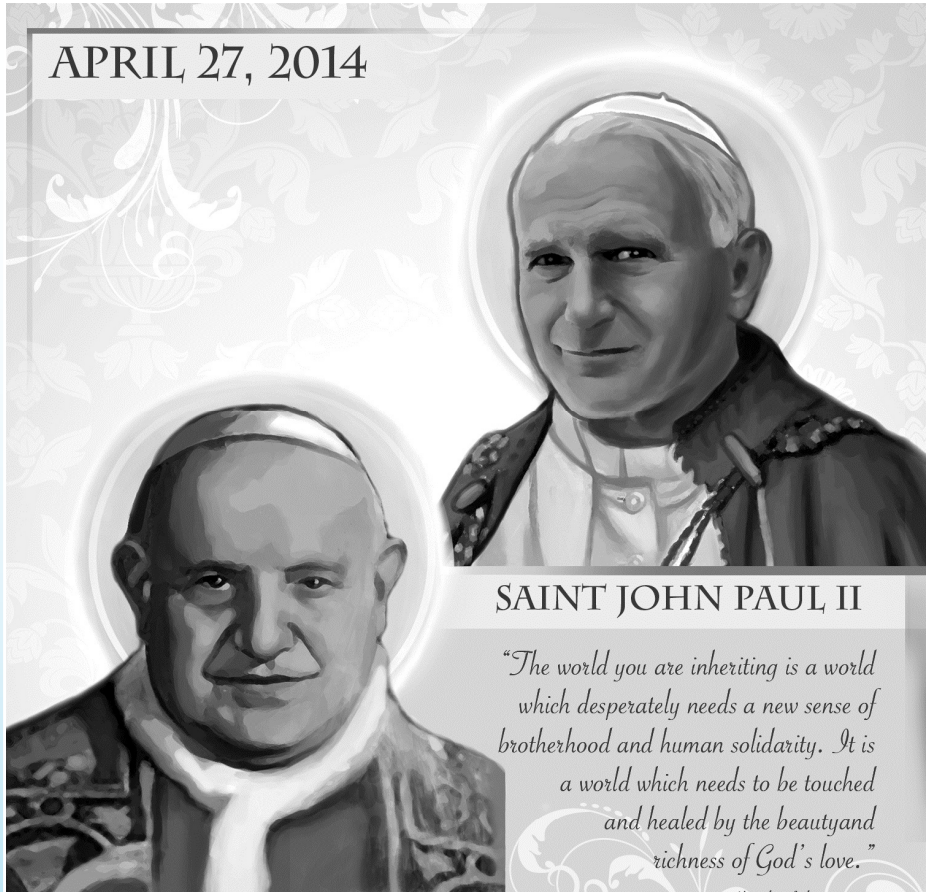

## Stewardship Message - April 27, 2014

**"What Gifts Do I Share?"**

Sunday of Divine Mercy

Today's gift in scripture is a summation of our Christian life. The first reading describes the community of believers being taught by the apostles and how they shared their possessions to provide for the needs of all. They continually praised God, prayed together and gave witness to the Love of God. Their example encouraged others to come to believe and join their community. In the second reading Peter highlights our inheritance in heaven as the goal that gives us great joy and also enduring strength when facing trials in our journey. When we keep our focus on heaven, we can endure all things. The Gospel then makes it clear that it is our faith that opens the life of Christ to us and leads us to salvation. Blessed are those who have not seen, but have believed! Jesus, the Word of God, offers mercy and forgiveness if we but treat each other with love. May God's love impel us to live in Christian unity.

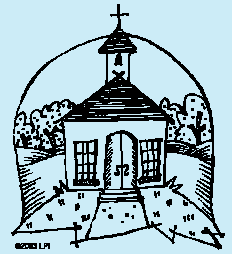
