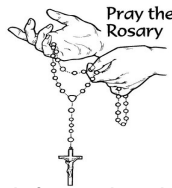
Tim Mathews, our Representative from Liturgical Publications, will be in the church offices the week of May 27th thru May 29th. This is a month later than previously announced.

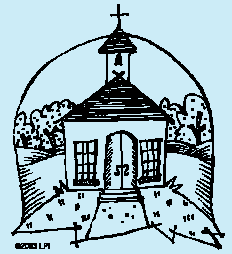
