

Fifth Sunday of Easter

**Thank you** - The Altar Society would like to say a big thank you to the KofC for serving our Mother's Day brunch last Sunday. You did a wonderful job.

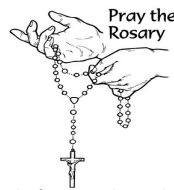
**Tim Mathews, our Representative from Liturgical Publications**, will be in the church offices the week of May 27th thru May 29th. This is a month later than previously announced.

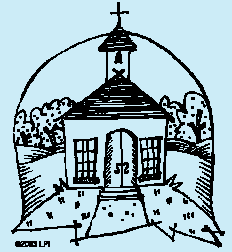
