Sixth Sunday of Easter

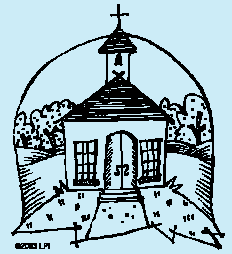
