Fifteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Word was God. These words, from the beginning of the Gospel of John, shed light on today's readings. Isaiah compares the Word of God to rain and snow which water the earth and make it fruitful. The Word, sent forth by God, will accomplish its mission on earth, bearing witness to the Father and inviting all peoples to experience the joy and freedom of the kingdom. St. Paul goes further by acknowledging the longing of creation for the kingdom once God's love has been revealed. Jesus sums up salvation history in the parable of the sower. Those who hear the Word and respond to it produce fruit many times over by bringing others to know the Lord through the lives they lead. May our ears be open to the Word and our hands be busy serving others.

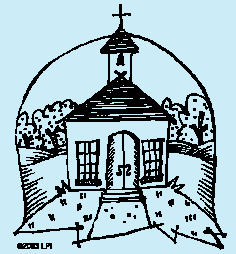
