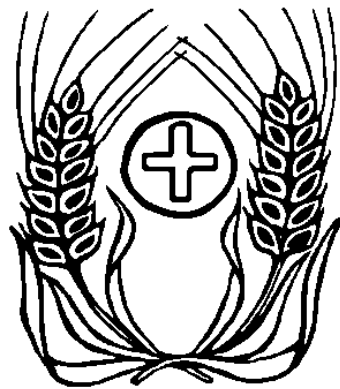
"Discover the Big Picture" of the Catholic Faith

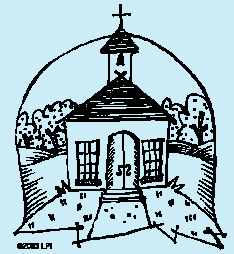
