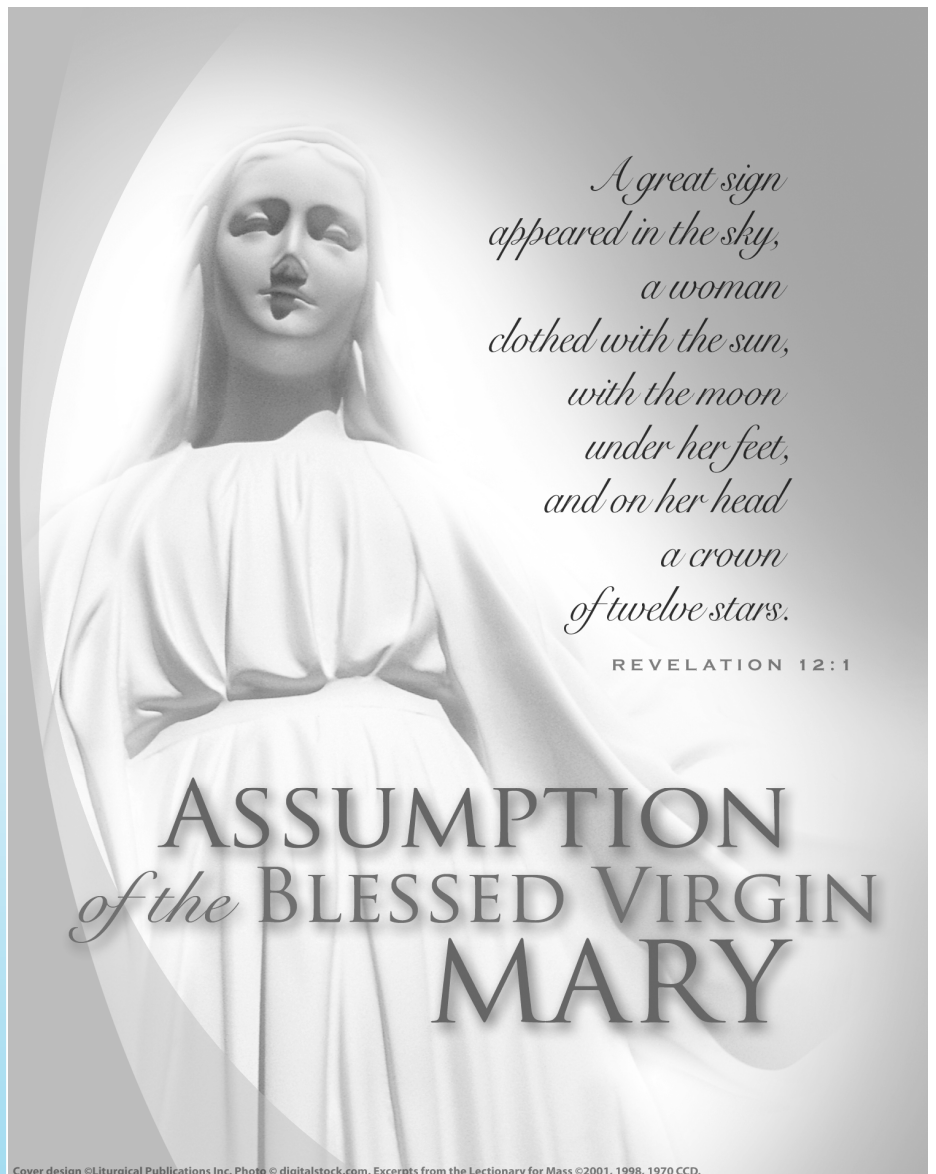

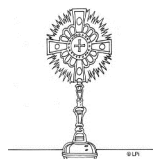

## Welcome to the New School Year!

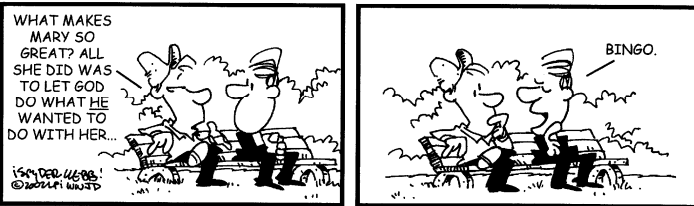
Our first day of school is Wednesday, August 13 with noon dismissal.

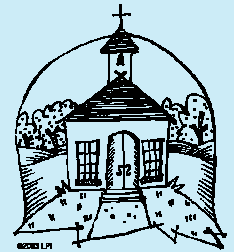
