

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

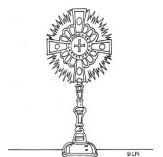

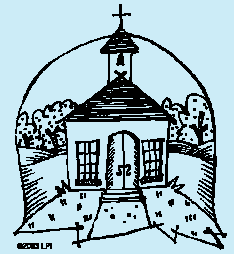

08/15 The Assumption of Mary: body & soul into heaven. 08/22 The Queenship of Mary; "Let all, therefore, try to approach with greater trust the throne of grace and mercy of Queen and Mother, and beg for strength in adversity,....." {Taken from Pope Pius XII Encyclical/ Ad Caeli Reginam, which established the memorial}.
