RELIGION

6TH GRADE: The 6th grade students finished learning about the Ten Commandments. Next they learned about how to make decisions & form their consciences. Then the 6th graders learned about God's forgiveness. Currently, they are discovering how God brought His chosen people to the Holy Land.

7TH GRADE: The 7th grade learned about Jesus' miracles. After that, they focused on the historical development of the Mass and the Mass today. Currently, they are reviewing the sacraments of healing.

8TH GRADE: The 8th grade class learned about the Enlightenment and its effect on the Church. They had a debate about Science and Religion. Students are now examining the historical development of the Mass and drawing pictures of each age.

SCIENCE

6TH GRADE: The students in 6th grade are continuing to explore planet Earth. They are studying the oceans and conducted experiments on salinity. They also created a model of the ocean floor and described the features.

7TH GRADE: The 7th graders are learning about energy and heat transfer. The students tested items to determine if they are conductors by using a circuit. Then they looked at thermal expansion by heating a nut and bolt. The 7th graders also did experiments involving temperature.

8TH GRADE: The 8th grade students finished the digestive system. They learned about cycles in nature and graphed their sleep cycles. The students are now starting a unit in which they will discover the rock cycle. The 8th graders are also preparing for the State Science Assessment by using Quizlet to review concepts learned in middle school.
