RELIGIÓN

SEXTO GRADO: Los alumnos del 6to grado han continuado con el estudio del Viejo Testamento. La clase ha aprendido las diferentes decisiones que los jueces tomaron en el Viejo Testamento. Los alumnos realizaron un trabajo en donde hicieron un reporte acerca de las Diez mujeres y su fe en el Viejo Testamento. Then they wrote a report about ten women of faith in the Old Testament. Next, they learned about the first three kings of Israel. The students also took the Steward Test after many hours of studying. Currently, they are learning about the Old Testament prophets.

7TH GRADE: The 7th grade students learned about the Beatitudes and Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy. They illustrated themselves practice each of these. They too took the Steward Test this month. The 7th graders are currently focusing on the life of Jesus.

8TH GRADE: The 8th grade class has been focusing on Church History. They examined the role of the Church in the U.S. They discovered the many missionaries that come to our country to spread the faith. The students also took the Steward Test. The big emphasis these past few months has been preparing for the Culminating Project!

SCIENCE

6TH GRADE: The students in 6th grade have finished their study of planet Earth. They learned about fresh water, landmasses and the interior of the Earth. They did a lab to demonstrate plasticity and created a diagram of the interior of the Earth. They are now learning about the circulatory system and nervous system.

7TH GRADE: The 7th grade discovered regional climates and how they are affected by various conditions. Next, the students learned about cell processes, such as cell division. They are now learning about light and its uses. They performed labs to demonstrate reflection and refraction.

8TH GRADE: The 8th grade students learned about reproduction and development in the human body. They then dissected frogs to compare the frog anatomy to the human anatomy. The 8th grade also took the Science State Assessment.
